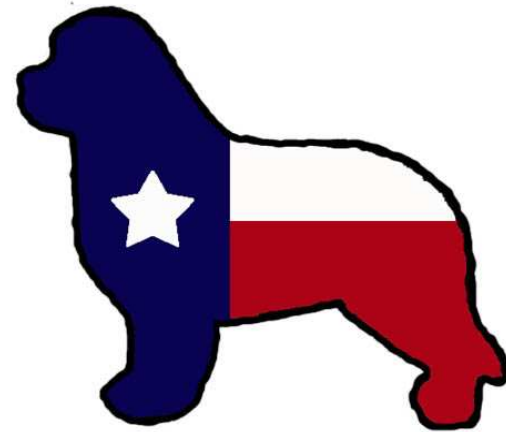

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, and of the holding of this event, and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or test secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises or grounds and the employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for such claim ; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim or loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person or any other causes.

Entries

Entries for all tests close September 14th, 2008 (or when the limit is reached) at the home of the test secretary, Karen Bailey, at which time entries cannot be cancelled, altered, or substituted. **Entries postmarked before July 31st, 2008 will be returned.** Confirmation notices will be mailed **after** entries close.

Entries are limited to Friday: 12 WD; Saturday: 6 WRDX & 12 WRD; Sunday: 24 single entries. **(No WRDX on Sunday)**. The **entry fee is \$35.00** for each dog, each day. Entries for requalification will be accepted only if the entry limit has not been met by untitled dogs.

Post Entries: Dogs who successfully fulfill the requirements for a Water Dog Title at a test may be post entered in the Senior Division at that test and will be tested at the conclusion of the Senior Division judging. The handler will be allowed to test his dog until it fails an exercise. **The post entry fee is \$15.00.**

Note: The NCA Working Dog Committee has approved the eligibility of WRD titled dogs to enter the Junior Division exercises at any NCA approved water test. These entries will be made on a space available basis so as not to exclude untitled Junior dogs. WRD titled dogs entering, whether or not they pass the Junior Division, may not post-enter the Senior Division that day.

Directions to Lake Kiowa

Go north on 75 to Exit #54 (902). Take a left off the ramp and then another left to cross over 75. This is marked 902 West. Go about 20 miles on 902 until you come to the town of Collinsville. Go through the first stop sign. At the second stop sign, turn left (377). Take the second right turn (902 West). The Lake Kiowa entrance is on your right about 6 miles on 902. You will be stopped at the Guard House. They will let you through only if we notified them that you are expected.

After you enter the gate, go straight and follow the newf signs to the beach and pavilion. If you get lost, just follow the signs marked Kiowa Drive. It circles the lake and will lead you to the beach.

- or -

Take 35W from Fort Worth or 35E from Dallas north. Go to exit 483 (Rt. 3002) Lone Oak. Turn right on 3002. Follow 3002 which becomes 372 north (8.4 miles). Cross Rt. 922 and Burn City. Proceed 13.2 miles from the 3002 exit to Rt. 3496 and a sign for Lake Kiowa. Turn right and follow Rt. 3496 (3.8 miles) to stop sign and Rt. 902 (Lake Kiowa sign). Turn right and proceed 0.3 miles to Lake Kiowa entrance on the left. Then follow directions to the beach above.

- or -

Coming form the north on I35, get off at the exit for 82 in Gainesville. Go east (towards Sherman). At the fifth light (Bell Supply on right) take a right (3092). At the second stop sign, take a left (902). There is a sign for Lake Kiowa. Go 6 miles to the Lake Kiowa entrance on your left. Then follow the directions to the beach above.

About Lake Kiowa

Lake Kiowa is a privately owned lake. We are holding the event at the west beach, which is mostly sand. The drop-off is fairly steep, so dogs will be swimming soon after leaving the shore. There is a covered pavilion with electricity and water, but the close spectator area is in the sun. There is a shady area and bathroom facilities nearby. Please bring your own chairs.

Important Rabies Information

Please remember to carry a copy of your dog's current rabies vaccination certificate with you. The Texas Department of Health has declared the state of Texas under a rabies quarantine. A dog without a current rabies certificate is subject to thirty days quarantine.
